The Board is aware that there are some sidewalks around the community that are cracked. The cracks do not pose any safety issues. Also, some of the asphalt roadways will need attention soon. The Board has decided not to make any repairs in 2019. We are currently planning on crack filling and sealing all of the asphalt roadways in 2020.

The Board is continuing to work with ForeverGreen to address the issues with courtyard 4. The second application of fertilizer has been applied and the courtyard is being watered regularly. With the hot and rainy weather we've experienced this year, it may be Fall before anything else can be done, if it is needed.

There is some caulking in the pool that needs to be replaced. Some residents have agreed to do this work. It will be done once the pool closes for the season. There are also a few tiles that need to be replaced. The company that built the pool is no longer in business and the Board has not been successful in finding another source of tiles to match what we have.
