The plan is to take the cover off the pool on May 20. The pool will be prepared for opening including doing some repair work and getting the chemicals balanced. The pool is expected to be open on May 25, weather dependent.

The irrigation system will be checked in May. Damaged sprinkler heads will be fixed or replaced as needed.
