On November 1, we sent an email to residents regarding the approval of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOA) between the City of North Ridgeville and the Northborough HOA regarding building a mound on our northern border. The MOU states that the city will provide the clean fill dirt and build the mound at no cost to the Northborough HOA. The city is in the process of building the mound. Dump trucks are bringing many loads of dirt into our community. We do not want anyone to be hurt by being in the area where heavy equipment is in use. Also, the city wants to get the mound completed before they need to switch the trucks over to snow plows, so we do not want to do anything to impede the work. Therefore, the Board is asking residents to please avoid the work area and to refrain from approaching the workers.
